# Course Details

## Duration and Completion

The Modular Woodworking Program spans up to six months, giving students the flexibility to complete modules at their own pace.

For those requiring additional time, a one-time extension of six months is available for a nominal fee.

This flexible structure allows you to thoroughly engage with each module, ensuring a deep understanding of advanced woodworking techniques without feeling rushed.





# Fees

## Course Fees

We offer flexible payment options to suit your needs:

### Complete Program Fee (7 Modules)

- Upfront Payment: AED 10,250 (includes all modules and mentorship).
- Pay-Per-Module: AED 13,500 total, allowing you to pay for each module individually.

### Starter Package (Modules 1 & 3)

- AED 4,250 for foundational skills, with the option to upgrade to the full program later.

# Payment

# Registration Form

## Terms and Conditions

### Program Fees

- The complete program fee is AED 10,250 (upfront) or AED 13,500 (pay-per-module).
- For the pay-per-module option, a non-refundable deposit of AED 1,500 is required at registration, which will be credited toward Module 7.
- Each module's fee must be paid before it starts

### Refund Policy

- Cancellations within two weeks of the course start date are non-refundable.
- A 50% refund is available for cancellations made at least two weeks before the program begins.
- Module fees are non-refundable once the module has commenced.

### Course Duration

- The program must be completed within six months of enrollment.
- A one-time extension for an additional six months is available for AED 500.

### Workshop Hours

- Workshop hours for each module must be completed within two weeks after tuition.
- Additional workshop hours can be purchased at AED 45 per hour.
- Unused workshop hours will not be refunded or carried over beyond the course end date.

### Personal Project Mentorship

For Module 7, students will have access to 20 hours of Resident Program time over one month. Additional mentorship is available at:

- AED 150 per hour for one-on-one tuition.
- AED 1,400 for 10 hours of mentorship.
- AED 2,700 for 20 hours of mentorship.

### Consultation Services

- A 1-hour personalized consultation is available for AED 200, offering assistance with tool selection, project planning, and workspace management.

### Attendance Policy

- Students are allowed one free reschedule per module with at least 24 hours notice.
- Further reschedules will incur an AED 200 fee per instance.

### Tools and Materials

- Core module materials are included in the program fee. Materials for Module 7's personal project must be purchased by students.
- Students must acquire their own hand tools, eligible for a 10% discount through The Makers Society.

### Storage Policy

- Free project storage is provided during Machine Safety and Machine Joinery modules.
- One month of free storage is offered post-program. Additional storage costs AED 150 per month.

### Certification

- Upon successful completion of all modules, students will receive an internal certification from The Makers Society.
